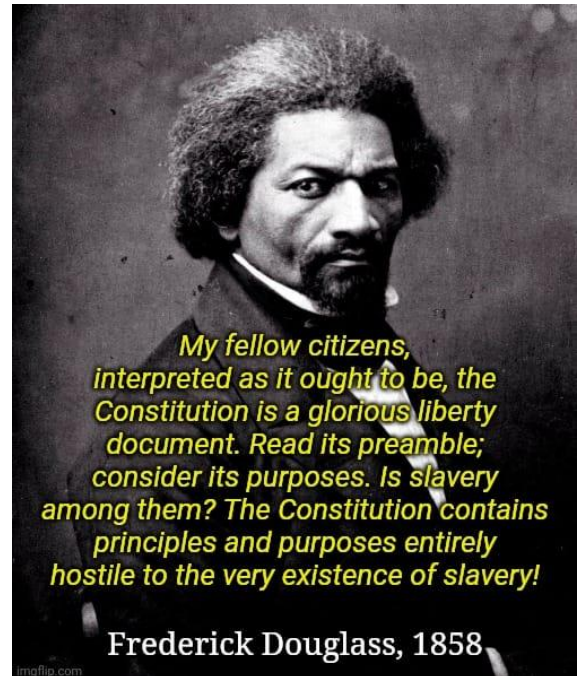

(In reality, the "3/5 Rule" provided an incentive to each State that FREED their slaves because each Free man was counted as full person, giving that State MORE Representatives in Congress and the same number of added Votes to cast for President!)



The Electoral College elected Lincoln, who's State Electors received just 39% of their respective State popular votes. Along with a bloody Civil War, it put an END to U.S. slavery.
