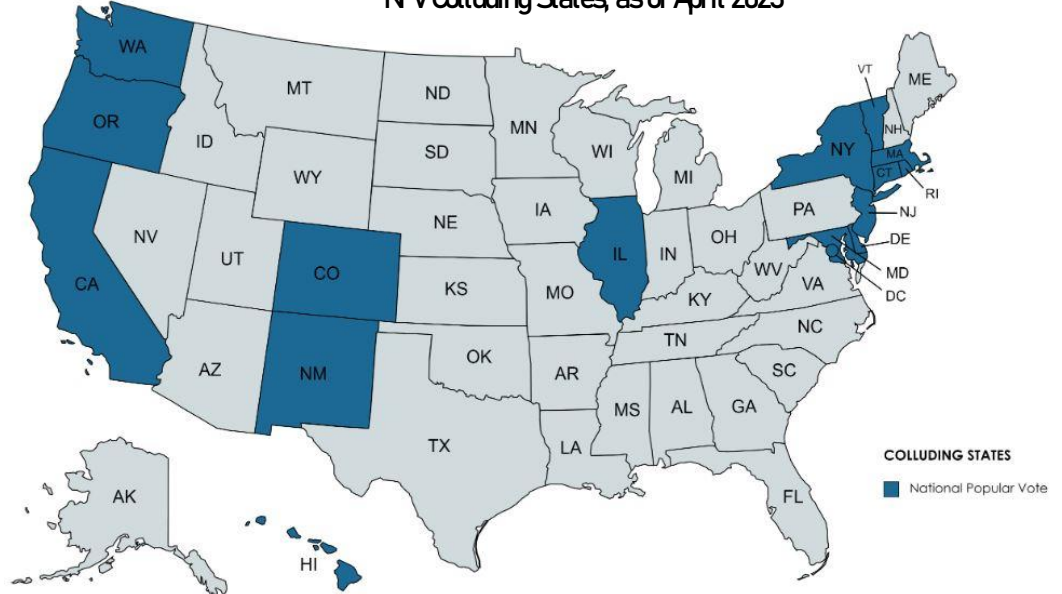

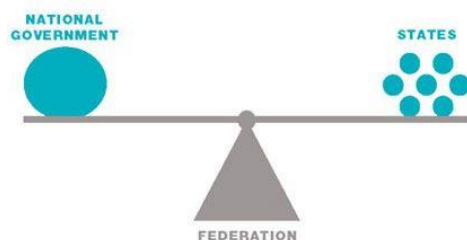
The "National Popular Vote Interstate Compact" ("NPV") scheme is actually a Contract of Collusion among a minority of the States that negates the non-colluding operation of the Electoral College – all without a Constitutional Amendment!

The ELECTORAL COLLEGE is nothing more than our STATES casting their Votes (called "Electoral Votes", and there are 538 of them) for candidates for President and Vice President of the United

STATES! Very importantly, it is also nothing LESS! The NPV cancels non-NPV-participating State Legislatures' right, role and responsibility to meaningfully change the Manner in which their Electors are chosen. It simply will not matter what any Non-NPV Legislature does, negating a critical power check against the Federal government – electing the CEO - as designed by our Founders. As of March 2023, 15 States and DC have joined the NPVIC. They represent 195 Electoral Votes. In the scheme, the States agree to activate it when they have 270 Electoral Votes enrolled, enough to control future Presidential elections.



They have been at this since 2006 and are already **72%** of the way there! **NPV LEGISLATION is pending as of March 2023** and moving in Alaska, Arizona, Florida, Maine, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nevada, North Carolina, South Carolina, Texas and Wisconsin. **Pro-Electoral College bills**, which we support, are pending in Arizona, Connecticut, Idaho, New Jersey and South Carolina. IDAHO and North Dakota have enacted PRO-EC laws!
